Community Refugee Integration & Settlement Pilot

Federal gov't program run by CRSA
Facilitates support of 1500 people during 2022-25

GMP

Group Mentorship Program

CRSA-led initiative launched in 2020
Facilitates support for 350+ people per year



A group of at least 5 adults who live near each other welcome and support a refugee household
The household is on a refugee or humanitarian visa with full access to Centrelink, Medicare, Work Rights etc

The group volunteers **10+hours of support per week** between them

Group provides ongoing practical support as required e.g. social connection, assist with driving lessons, finding employment,

Full settlement support

- 12 month commitment
- Fundraise approx \$5,000 - \$25,000
(depending on size of household & access to donated goods, 'free' housing etc)

Supplementary settlement support

- 6-12 month commitment
- Fundraise \$1,000 - \$3,000
(depending on size of household)



Refugees with Australian visas, coming from overseas

- Will move to the group's community
- Refugees are referred by UNHCR (not someone known to you)

Refugees already living in Australia

- Already have housing and gov't funded case worker
- Referred to CRSA by Australian agencies or self-referred



Group provides primary support on arrival

- Meet at airport
- Provide initial accommodation and income support (first few weeks)
- Provide basic household items (eg furniture, appliances)
- Assist family to enrol in Centrelink, Medicare, school etc



Group provides supplementary support post-arrival

- Groups provide support to supplement government-funded case management
