## Australian Capital Territory

### Future of Education Equity Fund

The ACT Government's expanded Future of Education Equity Fund provides financial assistance to low-income families (and independent students) with students in years P-12 to meet the costs of education expenses, such as school uniforms, school excursions, sport equipment, activities and music lessons through a one-off payment.

### Sports Voucher

The Sports Vouchers program provides a discount of up to \$100 on sport, dance or learn to swim fees for children living in South Australia in Reception to Year 9, each calendar year.

## Northern Territory

### Sports Voucher

Children living in an urban area are eligible to receive two \$100 sport vouchers each year. To be eligible, they must be enrolled in school. You can use the vouchers for sport, recreation and cultural activities. They can also be used for swimming and music lessons within school hours.
